Defendants and their employees, Defendants' respective parents, subsidiaries, and affiliates, and government entities are excluded from the Settlement Classes.

Your membership in the Settlement Classes is limited to those Settlements for which you have not requested exclusion. If you previously requested exclusion from one or more of the Settlements, you are not eligible to file a claim and receive settlement proceeds from that Settlement.

All Settlement Class Members who wish to receive any of the Lafarge, Thomas or Evans Settlement funds recovered in this lawsuit MUST submit a Claim Form by:

- Visiting the Settlement Website at www.SavannahConcreteCase.com to complete a Claim Form and file your claim online by DATE; or
- Completing and signing the Claim Form below and mailing it to the address listed at the top of this Notice so that it is postmarked by DATE.

As further instructed below, you may use your Claim ID and PIN Code listed at the top of page 1 to log in at www.SavannahConcreteCase.com, where you can review your sales information electronically. You may then submit your Claim Form directly online or complete and mail the Claim Form below with a postmark no later than DATE. If you received more than one Notice and Claim Form, you should file a claim for each Claim ID and PIN Code provided to you in a Notice and Claim Form.



HOW MUCH WILL I RECEIVE FROM THE SETTLEMENTS?

The Lafarge, Thomas and Evans Settlements have provided combined settlement payments of \$18,650,000 (the "Settlement Funds"). This amount will be increased by \$150,000 if Defendant Evans exercises its right under the Evans Settlement to pay a portion of its settlement amount on a later date.

Settlement Class Member distributions will be based on the amount of their Qualifying Purchases, which are those direct purchases of Ready-Mix Concrete from one of the Subject Plants during the Class Period for which a completed and signed Claim Form has been submitted by the Settlement Class Member.

If you are eligible for payments, the amount you will receive from the Settlement Funds will depend on: (1) the total amount of your Qualifying Purchases; (2) the total amount of other Settlement Class Members' Qualifying Purchases; and (3) the amount of litigation expenses, attorneys' fees, and class representative incentive awards approved by the Court.

Before Settlement Class Member distributions are calculated, the Net Settlement Funds will be determined by deducting any Court-approved costs of litigation, costs of settlement administration, attorneys' fees, and service fees for the Plaintiff class representatives. The Net Settlement Funds will then be distributed to Settlement Class Members who submitted qualifying claims on a pro rata basis according to the respective amount of their Qualifying Purchases.

Because the pro rata amount you will receive depends on the amounts of other Settlement Class Members' Qualifying Purchases, it is not possible at this time to determine how much you will receive. In general, your recovery will be calculated as follows:

HOW ARE MY QUALIFYING PURCHASES DETERMINED?

The Amount of Qualifying Purchases by Settlement Class Members will be determined by the Settlement Administrator as follows:

- The amount of your Qualifying Purchases <u>does not include materials or products other than Ready-Mix Concrete</u> (such as separately charged admixtures, additives such as fiber mesh, costs of building materials, concrete blocks, precast concrete products, equipment/tools, expansion joints, foam/Styrofoam, concrete forms, hardware, plastic, rebar, steel fiber, wire mesh, sealants, and test cylinders), and it does not include services for which an extra charge is assessed (such as special delivery charges, truck/equipment rental charges, minimum load charges, overtime charges, same-day-service charges, truck cleanup charges, weekend/holiday/after-hours service charges). However, Qualifying Purchases <u>do include</u> environmental fees and fuel surcharges.
- The amount of your Qualifying Purchases from the Subject Plants, as determined from records provided by the Defendants, is available by using your Claim ID and PIN Code listed at the top of this document to log in at www.SavannahConcreteCase.com.
- If you believe that the actual amount of your Qualifying Purchases is higher than the amount that has been determined from the Defendants' records, you may complete and submit a Purchase Audit Request Form with supporting documentation. The Settlement Administrator will review the request and documentation submitted by you and determine whether the amount of your Qualifying Purchases should be the original amount, your proposed higher amount, or some different amount.
